for a maximum of six individuals that will not only meet the specialized medical, physical and cognitive needs of this challenged population, but will nourish and enhance social connections, dignity and honor individual preferences. Each resident enjoys either a private or shared room with an adjoining bath. Common living areas include an open kitchen, sunny dining room and comfortable living room. All meals are made onsite with attention to our resident's likes and special dietary needs.

Our goal is to make Unlimited Possibilities at City View the new paradigm for caring for persons with dementia. . . with sensitivity, expertise, and tenderness.
